British historian Dr. Arnold Joseph Toynbee (1889-1975), an author of numerous books and a research professor in international history, is best known for his 12-volume *A Study of History* and was considered a leading specialist on international affairs. His books have been translated into many languages. By studying the rise and fall of twenty-six major civilizations, he concluded that the decline of a civilization stems from the incompetence of moral and religious challenges.

In Choose Life: A Dialogue Between Arnold Toynbee & Daisaku Ikeda, Dr. Toynbee said, "The Weltanschauung that follows from these more perceptive and less aggressive religious and philosophical traditions is the one that now offers the most

promising hope of salvaging mankind. The injunction to "subdue," which modern man has taken as his directive, is immoral, impractical, and disastrous."

He pointed out that the world nowadays is in much the same state of mind as the Chinese were in the third century B.C. But the Chinese overcame that chaotic era and succeeded for centuries in not only holding together millions of people in relatively stable domestic peace and order but in assimilating a foreign ideology, Buddhism, in a way that enriched the indigenous civilization, and retained its cultural unity.

He sighed with sentiment, "We are the prisoners of an age-old habit of political disunity and of consequent warfare between competing states. This habit has become so deeply ingrained that we are reluctant to be liberated from it; yet we now recognize that if we fail to unite politically on a global scale, the annihilation of distance may result in the annihilation of life."

Dr. Toynbee said that the past achievements and historical experience of Chinese culture have endowed it with the qualifications that the West so conspicuously lacks. On the strength of that achievement, "Chinese culture" has a more promising chance of shepherding mankind into political unity than any other measures.

This is an analysis from a Western historian nearly a century ago when the world was not quite as turbulent as it is today. Dr. Toynbee concluded that we must find a solution from Confucianism, Daoism, and Buddhism, to save humankind.
